In 2009, he organized The Local Express Tour; a marketing company designed to provide art-inspired promotion to local businesses and artists throughout California. In 2013, he co-launched The ANTSS Project in San Joaquin County to provide immediate employment assistance to formerly incarcerated individuals to reduce recidivism and encourage healthier

transitions back into society. Later that year, he began serving as a casting and marketing consultant to several community theatre organizations in Northern California.
